Description of quality, condition & amenity of room

Standard rooms (Peter Comas Wing)

These rooms are well maintained with generous wardrobe space which includes a lockable drawer for storage of personal items. The main lounge is tastefully decorated with fireplace and mantelpiece and opens onto a veranda and garden area. The lounge is central to this area enabling residents to move freely. There are additional smaller lounges provide for family gatherings. One of these lounges ha a small kitchenette available for the use of visitors and families. The lounge and dining areas both open out to the garden area which has a meandering path around fragrant flora. There are a range of ornaments in the garden to interest people as they stroll around. The lounge and dining room are furnished reminiscent of the 1950's/1960's and in keeping with resident memories. A piano provides residents the opportunity to have sing-alongs and concerts. There is a family room available for small family functions and overnight stays. This is equipped with a sofa bed, table, TV and an ensuite and the facilities to prepare beverages.

This is a safe secure environment providing safety for residents.

All rooms and ensuites have the universal design principles for people with physical disabilities which supports ageing in place.

The room is enabled for pay TV. There is extra storage space within the room and a bar fridge is provided. A number of the rooms also have a full kitchenette in place.

Premium Rooms

These large single rooms have attractive, quality furnishing and fittings throughout. There is a built-in wardrobe wit a secure storage area for personal items. These rooms are well maintained and have ample space for personal furniture.

A picture rail on two walls enables the display of a range of memorabilia. The room has a personally controlled heating/cooling system with a heated ensuite.

There is a phone in the room which receives incoming calls and phone lines are available for personal connection, the room is enabled for pay TV.

A key feature of these rooms is they all have a full kitchenette.

There is also ample space for a computer and additional furnishing.

Description of quality, condition and amenity of common areas to which residents will have access

The entrance to the facility is welcoming with a coffee shop. This is operated by a team of dedicated volunteers and provides a café atmosphere for residents and visitors.

The café feel of the home is extended into the dining room with small personal seating areas

The café feel of the home is extended into the dining room with small personal seating areas which enhances the dining experience. The dining room itself has wonderful mountain views and opens out onto an attractive paved courtyard. The courtyard has plentiful seating and is perfect for outdoor activities. The barbecue area is available for families and friends to use. Barbecue events are a feature of the activity program.

Smaller lounge areas are located throughout the home and are available for use by family and friends. These lounge areas have comfortable eating, TV and feature a well-equipped kitchenette. The facility is set in picturesque gardens with ample walking paths and garden seating to encourage a stroll in the fresh air. Activities take place in a range of rooms and spaces which complement the different activities.

There is a well-stocked library including daily newspapers and magazines. The library includes a computer kiosk with 2 computers with internet connection available to all residents.

The home features a private outgoing telephone service at standard Telstra rates.

All rooms are in line with universal design principles for the needs of people with physical disabilities enabling ageing in place to occur.

There is an interesting and varied daily leisure and lifestyle activities program which is modified according to the needs and interests of residents. A Pastoral Carer provides spiritual and emotional support to residents and their families. A Physiotherapist undertakes an assessment of all new residents to identify mobility requirements and is assisted in this role by a physiotherapy assistant who works on a one to one basis with residents. A range of allied health services are provided including podiatry, physiotherapy and speech therapist. A music therapist is also contracted to deliver a service **Description of** for residents. any additional care or services There is a large volunteer program which provides support to residents in a range of activities. offered at no Entertainers visit the facility to perform for residents and are always well received. additional cost The facility also offers residents the opportunity to participate in an intergenerational program wit a local high school.
