Superior


Opening to a private balcony to sit out in a fresh air and soak in the leafy views, these delightfully appointed 18m² private ensuited rooms feature:

Basic Daily Care Fee

The Basic Daily Care Fee covers your day-to-day living costs in residential aged care such as standard meals, cleaning, and laundry, heating and cooling.

The Basic Daily Care Fee is set by the Federal Government, is the same in every residential facility and is calculated as 85% of the single person rate of the basic age pension. It is indexed with the age pension (it increases when the aged pension increases) and is adjusted every March and September.

Additional Services

Southern Cross Care provides additional services for a small daily fee on top of the Basic Daily Care Fee, to support our residents' lifestyle and wellbeing. Depending on the location, these additional services may include recreational activities, greater choice of meals, entertainment, outings, and other options tailored to personal preferences.
