The room has a personally controlled heating/cooling system with a heated ensuite. There is a phone in the room which receives incoming calls and phone lines are available for personal connection. The room is enabled for pay TV. There is extra storage space within the room and a bar fridge is provided. A number of the rooms also have a full kitchenette in place.

Description of quality, condition and amenity of common areas to which residents will have access	The entrance to the facility is welcoming with a coffee shop. This is operated by a team of dedicated volunteers and provides a cafe atmosphere for residents and visitors. The cafe feel of the home is extended into the dining room with small personal seating areas which enhances the dining experience. The dining room itself has wonderful mountain views and opens out onto an attractive paved courtyard. The courtyard has plentiful seating and is perfect for outdoor activities. The barbecue area is available for families and friends to use. Barbecue events are a feature of the activity program. Smaller lounge areas are located throughout the home and are available for use by family and friends. These lounge areas have comfortable seating, TV and feature a well-equipped kitchenette. The facility is set in picturesque gardens with ample walking paths and garden seating to encourage a stroll in the fresh air. Activities take place in a range of rooms and spaces which complement the different activities. There is a well-stocked library including daily newspapers and magazines. The library includes a computer kiosk with 2 computers with internet connection available to all residents.
Description of any specific accommodation or design features of the room, and the facility, to which a person in this oom would have access	All rooms are designed in line with universal design principles for the needs of people with physical disabilities enabling ageing in place to occur.
Description of any additional care or services offered at no additional cost	 There is an interesting and varied daily leisure and lifestyle activities program which is modified according to the needs and interests of residents. A Pastoral Carer provides spiritual and emotional support to residents and their families. A Physiotherapist undertakes an assessment of all new residents to identify mobility requirements and is assisted in this role by a physiotherapy assistant who works on a one to one basis with residents. A range of allied health services are provided including podiatry, physiotherapy and speech therapist. A music therapist is also contracted to deliver a service for residents. There is a large volunteer program which provides support to residents in a range of activities. Entertainers visit the facility to perform for residents and are always well received. The facility also offers residents the opportunity to participate in an intergenerational program with a local high school. The facility has a bus which takes residents on regular outings within the local area including shopping expeditions which are always well received.
Description of any additional costs associated with the room	A hairdressing salon is available on site. The hairdresser will also visit residents in their rooms where required. A visiting beautician is available to provide a range of services. Personal access to a physiotherapist for private consultancy is available.
